A couple of cool things that I wanted to show you about them is that they come in six shapes, so kind of like a small assortment in that way but they are an offset painting knife (Julie shows the offset feature) which means that the blade comes out from the handle and then dips down it doesn't just come straight out. The handle is a lacquered wood which is extremely lightweight. I don't know what kind of wood it is but it's really nice because it's not terribly heavy and the whole thing has an extremely light feel. It's not cumbersome at all. The blades have a nice spring to them. They're not super super rigid and one of the things that I really like about it is that it has this flattened back. (Julie shows the back) It's like a little bevel on the back and the reason for that is that when you lay it down it's not going to roll around. But it also has this other feature where it has an enlarged base (Julie shows the base) that's flat so that you don't have to lay it down. You know because if you're using your painting knife and it has paint all over it, when you lay it down it gets all over everything so these have the ability for you to stand them up (Julie stands one up) and they're really pretty sturdy. They're not all wiggling around and not falling over so it's kind of a nice feature that most painting knives don't have. So check them out.
