Hello and welcome to Cheap Joe's Art Stuff. My name is Julie and I'm here to impart some knowledge to you today via a Two-Minute Art Tip. And today I wanted to introduce you to a really handy Cheap Joe's product that maybe you aren't familiar with (the product webpage appears on screen and it has pictures of the clips and a quick overview with product features) called The Cheap Joe's Magnetic Bulldog Clips. These actually come two to a pack. They're fairly small but kind of hefty, but they're a really unique tool especially for working plein air because it provides you with like a little extra set of hands, and I'll show you what I mean.

I've got a Kilimanjaro Watercolor

Paint Book (on screen is an overhead shot that has the paint book which Julie is opening to a blank white page. Also in the shot is a small six bin Nomad Palette which has six colors in it plus a set of Bulldog Clips, they're also on the screen) which is really nice because it's got interlaced sketch pages in here and stuff. We're going to take this and put one of our Bulldog Clips on here (as Julie said, she took the bulldog clip and attached it to the left corner of the paint book and then attached The Nomad Palette to the bulldog clip). So I'll flip it over here so our magnetic side is up, you can see exactly what I'm doing, but I've got one of our little teeny Nomad Palettes here and this allows us to have our palette right here. Maybe you have your wash water close by and I got my little cute interlocking nylon travel brush here (Julie has a short green handle travel brush in hand and picks up green paint from the Nomad Palette

and applies it to the paper) and so this is going to allow us to have ready access to our palette and our color and we're not going to have to worry about stuff falling off into the grass, rolling around where we can't ever find it again, and being super annoyed. (Julie continues to add the paint, this time a yellow color, to the paper.) So this is a really kind of wonderful little tool, just a couple of bucks, and this is going to give you (this time Julie adds blue paint to the paper) easy access to your material on the go while you're working out in the field or even in the studio. Maybe you've got an easel and you're looking to put some extra tools on that easel (Julie is still painting and it turns out to be a quick landscape scene on the paper with a green tree), you can use this magnet and then have some extra ready access to those things with just a clip. (The product web page appears back on screen with pictures of the clips and a quick
